GPA (high school or cum college)	Multiply cumulative GPA by 10, i.e. 3.51 = 35.1	
ACT	Minimum scores in each area of: 25 or higher = 13 20-24 = 10 0-19= 0	
Holds previous degree from an accredited college (credit given for one degree only)	10
